Experiment with colour, design, texture, form and function



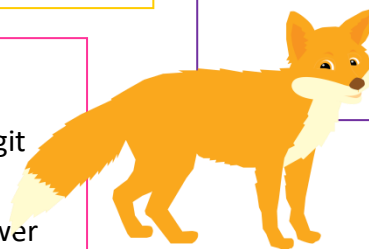
Literacy
