-cious or -tious?

The **shus** sound is often found in adjectives and can be spelt in two different ways: **cious** or **tious**. For example:

- delicious, precious, suspicious
- fictitious, infectious, nutritious



cious as in 'a delicious dessert'



tious as in 'an infectious illness'

Sometimes a root word will give you a clue which spelling to choose, for example:

Words ending in tion change to tious: ambition > ambitious

Words ending in ce change to cious: grace > gracious
