Day	What is the video about?	What is the activity for today?	What will you need? (Including attached resources)
Mon	Phonics Revision of vowel suffixes	Wake up Warm up: Speedy sounds (on video).  Short and Long vowel rules. Look through your reading book and find examples of words that use the doubling, dropping or do nothing rule. Make a list of them.	Pencil Paper Reading Book Vowel Suffix Rule Help Sheet
Tues	GPS Revising the different sentence types.	Wake up Warm up: Up level the sentence - The car started (on video).  Go around your house and find 'boring' items e.g. a saucepan. Can you say out loud the 4 different sentence types and relate it to the item? You do not need to write anything.	Pencil Paper Sentence Type poster (attachment)
Weds	GPS Practise writing different sentence types.	Wake up Warm up: How many words can you make from 'Kingslea Primary School'? (on video)  4 in a row. Copy the attached grid or print it off. Can you write different sentences to get 4 in a row? Can you defeat a partner? This can be a grown up, sibling or even your dog!	Pencil Paper Game Grid (attachment)
Thurs	GPS Revising the use of a or an.	Wake up Warm up: Short Vowel Song (on video).  Today you are going to the market! What will you buy? Can you alternate your items between 'a' and 'an'? Fri	Spelling Weekly spelling practise.	Wake up Warm up: Speed read last week's spellings. Can you quickly tell us what they mean? (on video).  Look at your group's spellings for the week (attached).
