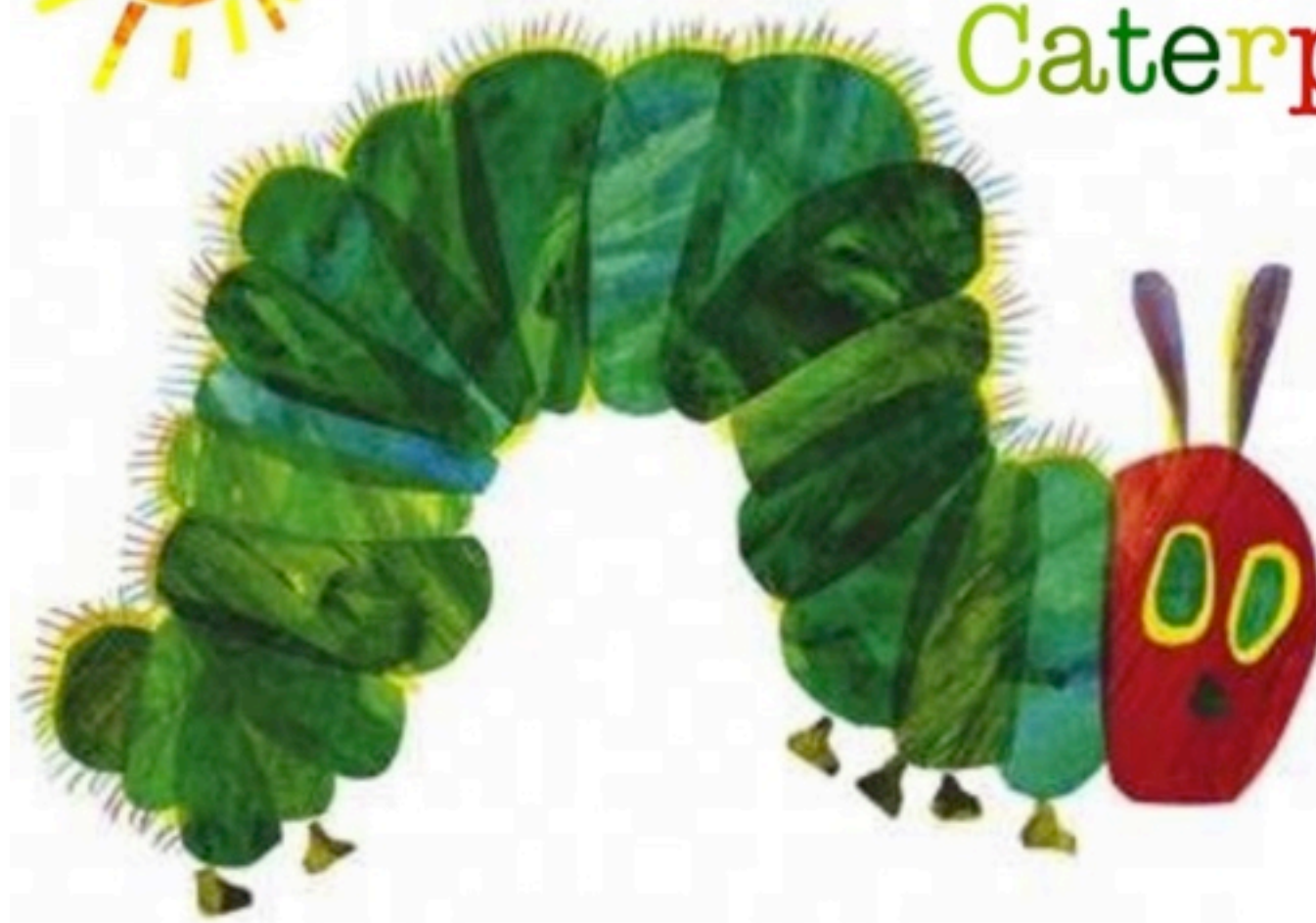
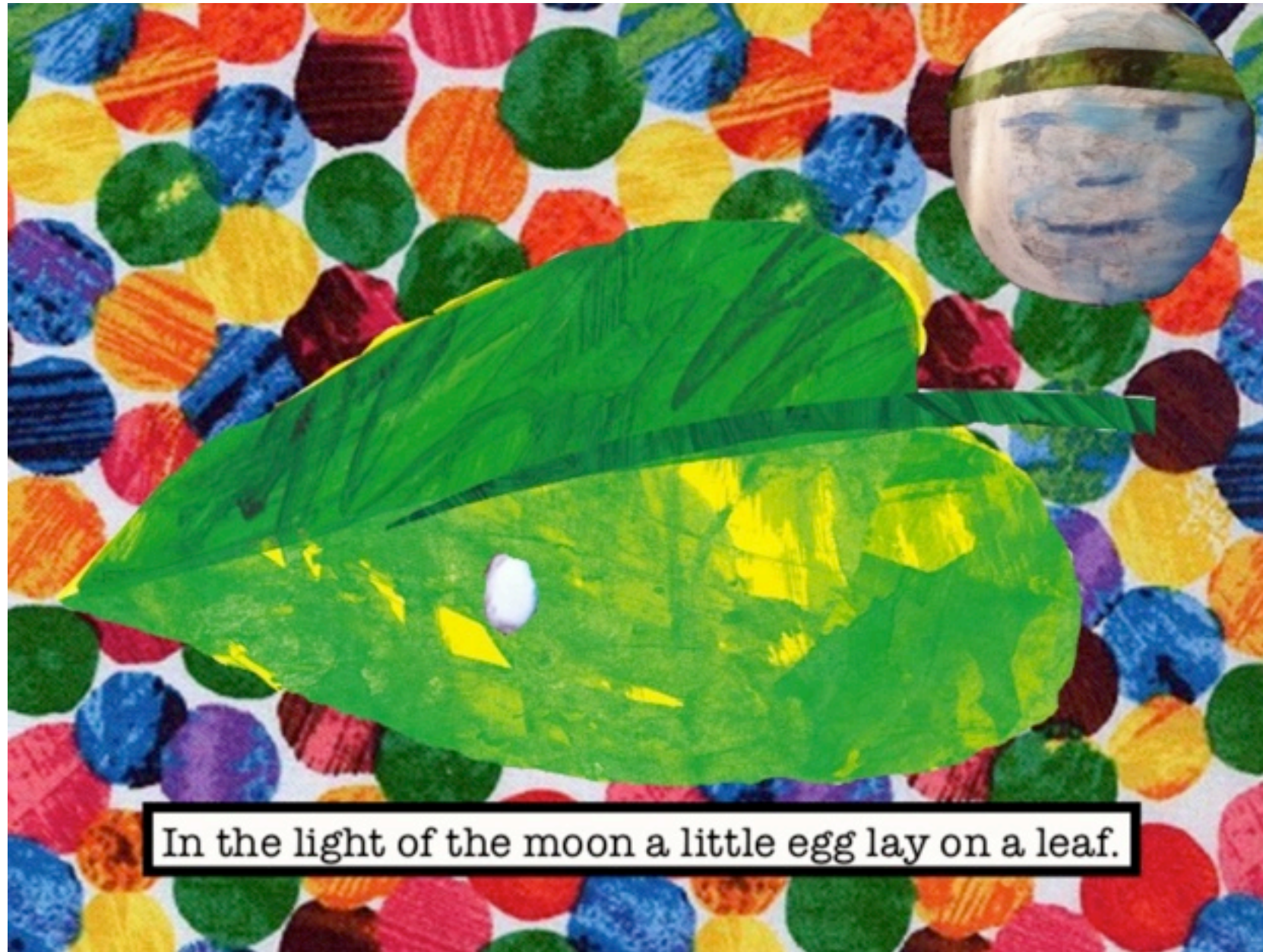




The Very

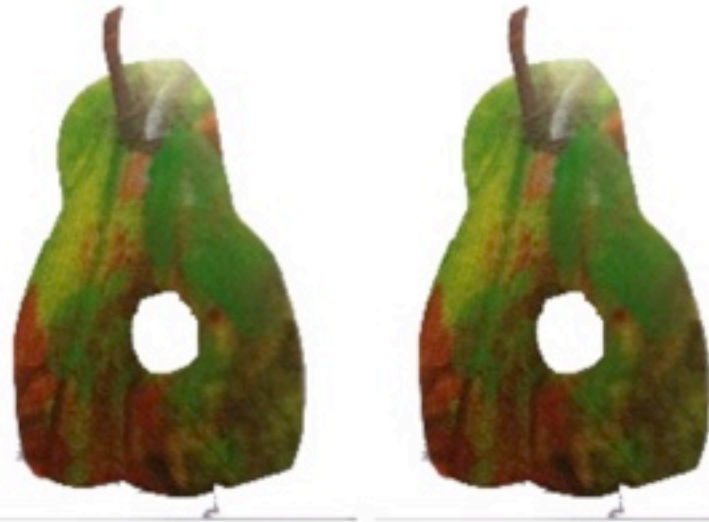

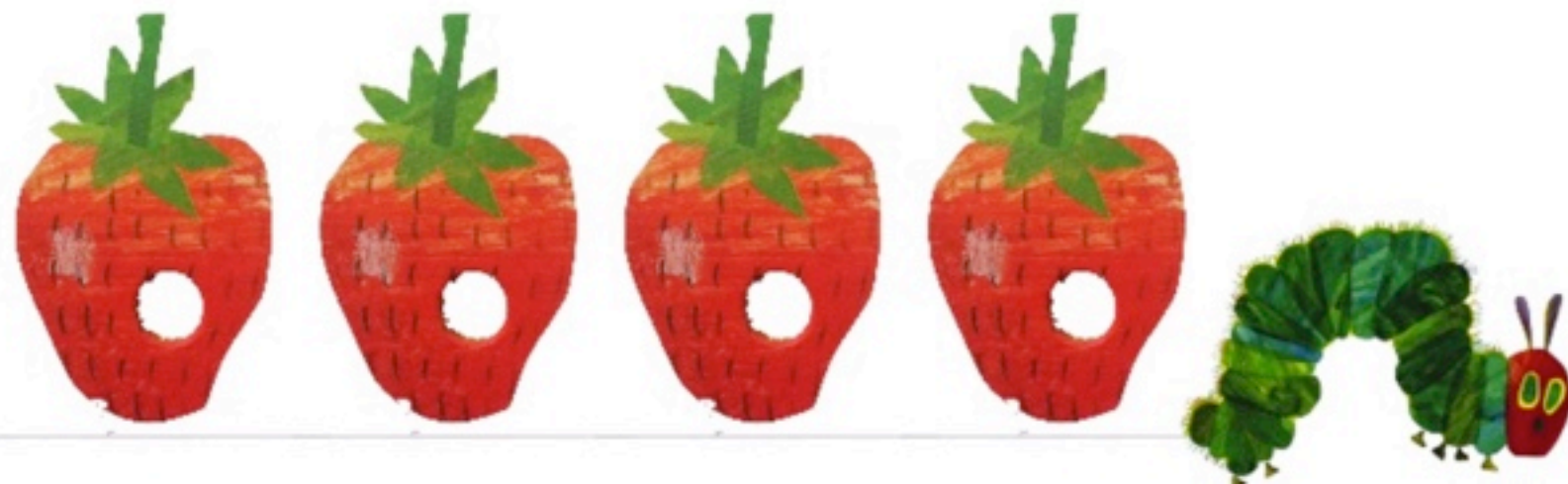

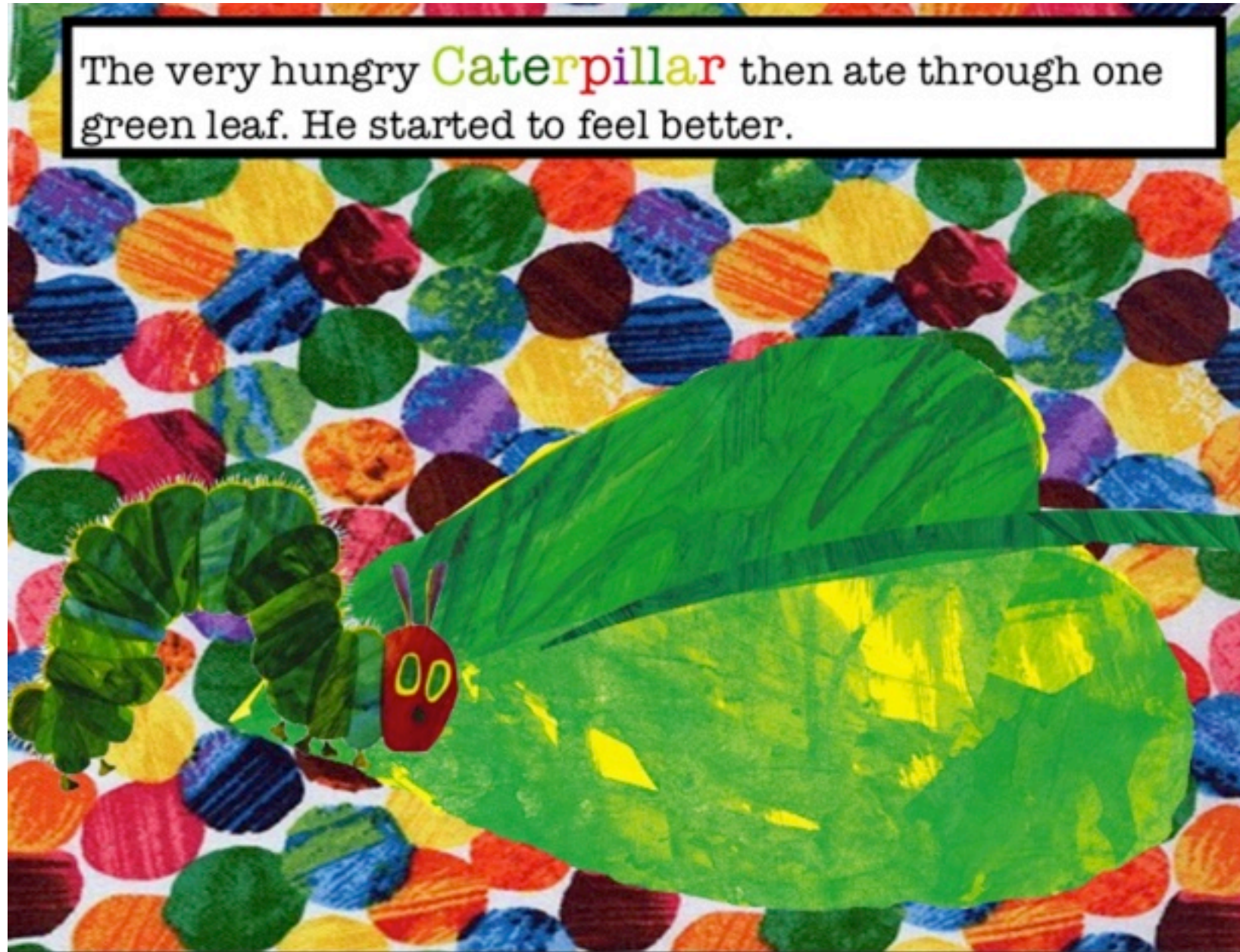
And 1 slice of watermelon.
