Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to the Summer Term.

As you know one of the areas that we feel is a strength of the school are the trips, events and curriculum enhancements that we put on. At the end of the last term, Y5 visited Greenwich Museum as part of their Exploration Learning Journey, Y6 orienteered around Leechpool Woods to put their map reading skills into practice and in the last two weeks Y5 have visited the QM studio to record the lyrics and music they have written, Y4 have visited St. Mary's Church and Horsham Park, and it was Kingslea Day at Horsham FC.

As we look forward to this term I thought I would highlight some of the events that are taking place.

We have our Day of Art for each year group where you can come and spend the afternoon with your child working on a piece of art. Siblings are welcome and weather permitting we will be outside.

We also have the opportunity for grandparents to visit on Friday 7th June at 2.00pm. We very much value the connection that many children have with their grandparents and inviting grandparents into school allows them to see what their grandchild gets up to during the school day and to reminisce about their time in school. Grandparents bring a real sense of fun, energy and enjoyment into school.

Sports Day will be on Tuesday 25th June (with Thursday 27th June as the reserve date). All parents and family members are invited and we will be starting just after 9.00am. The format will be the same as the last few years: children will take part in a carousel of activities with the morning ending with numerous parent races!

Later this term we will be visiting Bocketts Farm which will be Reception's first Kingslea trip; Y6 are off to Swanage for a week; Y2 are visiting Drusilla's and Y4 will be spending a night camping on the school field.

Y5 will be taking part in the Horsham Children's Parade on Sunday 7th July. We are running a parade club this year, as well as working with an artist to help them prepare for this fabulous community event. Everyone is invited to watch the parade and join in with events in the park on that day.

This Summer Term we will be holding an Open Day on Tuesday 9th July

3.30pm –6.00pm, rather than a parents' evening. During this time, families can visit the school, look at your child's books, talk to the class teacher and see the work your child has been doing this year. You can also visit your child's new classroom and meet the new class teacher.
