bird	An animal with two wings, two feet and a body covered with feathers.
compass	An instrument for showing direction. It usually has a moving magnetic needle that points north.
environment	The things and conditions that are all around someone or something.
fauna	A group of animals in a particular area.
flora	A group of plants in a particular area.
flower	The part of a plant that has petals and can make fruit or seeds.
human features	Human features are things that are built or have been put in place by humans.

	leaf	Usually the flat parts of a plant that grows from the stem or branch.
	life	The state of being that sets animals and plants apart from things that are not alive.
Sunflower Life Cycle	life cycle	The sequence of changes that a living thing goes through as it grows and develops.
	map	A picture of a particular area of the earth drawn or printed to scale on a flat surface.
	muscle	The tissue in the body of animals and humans that moves parts of the body.
	nutrients	A substance that helps people, animals and plants live and grow.
	physical features	Physical features are natural objects that have not been influenced by humans.
	root	The part of a plant that usually grows underground. Roots take up water and nutrients and anchors the plant in the soil.

skeleton	The inner framework of bones and cartilage in vertebrate animals.  Skeletons support the body and protect softer body parts.
Spring	The season after winter and before summer where plants begin to grow.
stem	The main part of a plant that grows up from the ground and supports the branches, leaves, flowers, or fruits that may grow from it.
vegetation	Plants or plant life in a particular place.
