#### **Reading**

Play a 'beat the detective' with your child. Cut some paper into rectangles and write these words:

- Feet
- Play
- Star
- Barn
- Sleep
- Clay

Tell your child that all these words have digraphs in (ay, ee or ar). Place the words on the floor or on a table across the room. Say one of the words and your child must run, read the word and bring the correct one back to you before you write the word. You could even do this outside! You could also use different words if your child enjoys this game.

#### **Writing/English**

Can you write a shopping list?

Let your child to write a list for your next trip to the shops. Encourage careful sounding out of words. Your child could also write a sentence;

E.g. I need shampoo so I can wash my hair!

Can you solve some subtraction calculations? Eg 5-2?

Continue to practise this from yesterday. Encourage your child to write the calculations in their purple book.
