## Sunday morning



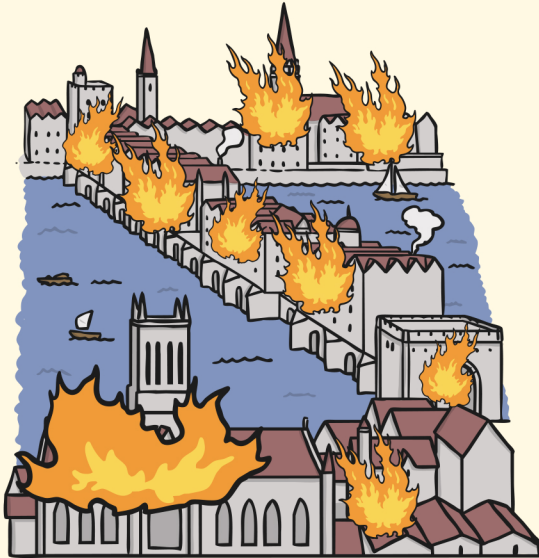
Samuel Pepys starts to record the unfolding events in his diary.

## Sunday evening



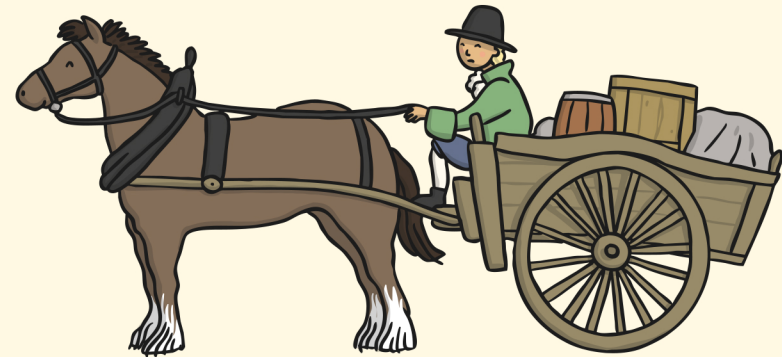
Houses are pulled down in an attempt to stop the fire spreading.
