



















# Victorian Vocabulary List

	abacus	A wooden beaded resource that was used in schools to help children to count.
	artefact	An artefact is an ornament, tool, or other object that was used in the past.
	blackboard	A large board that was on the wall for the teacher to write on with chalk.
	cane	A long stick that was used to punish children who misbehaved.
	chimney brush	A tool a Chimney Sweep used to clean chimneys with.
	chimney sweep	This person's job was to clean out the soot from chimneys.
	dunce cap	A pointy hat that children had to wear if they misbehaved.
	empire	A group of countries ruled over by a single monarch.
	ink bottle	A dip pen would be placed into the ink and then used to write on paper.
