

Multiplication and division - more complex problems

A bag contains 45 sweets.  
Nancy put them equally into 5 bags  
and then shared the bags  
equally to her 3 friends.  
How many bags of sweets did  
each of her friends receive?



Mal bought 3 boxes of pencils.  
Each box had 10 pencils.  
He shared the pencils equally with  
Rosie, Zach and himself.  
Zach shared his pencils with his 2 sisters.  
How many pencils did  
each of his sisters receive?



A pack contains 3 vegetables.  
Susan has 4 packs of vegetables.  
Amy has twice as much as Susan's.  
How many vegetables does Amy have?



Each folder contains a story  
with 3 chapters.

Each chapter has 5 pages.

Anne and Daisy were reading the stories.

Anne has finished reading 2 folders  
while Daisy has finished reading  
twice as many as Anne.

How many pages has Daisy read so far?



Anthony has 3 hens.

Each hen lays eggs three times a week.

Every hen lays two eggs each time.

How many eggs will they lay in two weeks?
