Day	What is the video about?	What is the activity for today?	What will you need? (Including attached resources)
Mon	Comparing and balancing addition and subtraction calculations using comparing symbols	Use our tens and ones jottings to solve today's calculations. There is a recap of our jottings on the video. Once you have solved the calculations, use the comparing symbols to compare or balance the calculations. Some subtraction calculations will require you to regroup – there is an explanation and model of this on the video.	Paper Pencil Calculations – attached Comparing symbols poster – attached
Tues	Looking at related facts for addition and subtraction	Use your knowledge of addition and subtraction of ones and relate these facts to addition and subtraction of tens. This method is explained and modelled in today's video. <u>Helpful conversation starters and questions to ask:</u> If I know _____ then I know _____ What's the same? What's different? Weds	Recapping number bonds of 10 and relating these to number bonds of 100 using related facts	Use your number bonds of 10 knowledge and relate this to learning number bonds of 100. Use the ten frames (attached) to help recall and represent your bonds. Write the addition and subtraction fact family calculations alongside each bond. This is modelled on today's video.	Paper Pencil Tens frames sheet – attached Extra challenge - attached
Thurs	Adding 3 one digit numbers using known number facts	Use your known number facts of number bonds of 10, doubles and near doubles to find a short cut when adding 3 one digit numbers. The method is modelled in today's video. Use the grids (attached) to practise this method.	Paper Pencil One digit number slips – attached Adding 3 digit number calculations – attached Extra challenge – attached
