Complete these multiplication questions using the grid method and your times tables. All questions use either your knowledge of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 or 10 times tables.

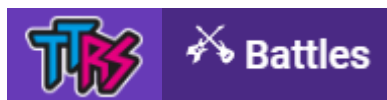
