It is RIC day today! Spend about 20 minutes completing the attached RIC. Remember to write your answers in full sentences with lots of detail.

1. Check closely for capital letters and full stops. Read one sentence at a time. Do you have enough full stops?

3. Can you add in two expanded noun phrases to add more detail?
4. Can you add in a subordinating conjunction to extend one of your sentences?
5. Can you add in three adverbs into your writing to describe your verbs?
