
As reading is so important, please continue to read over the holidays! We have been really impressed with some of the good quality comments that we have been sent from your reading journals. Keep it up!



Sphinx

The Great Sphinx is a mythological creature with the body of a lion and the head of a person. It was carved from a mound of natural rock and is located in Giza where it guards the front of tombs and temples. It is one of the largest and oldest statues in the world carved around 2500 BC. It's 73 metres long, 6 metres wide and 20 metres high.
