#### Maths

*CGP Book:* Pages 12-13 'Rounding' TIPS: Remember your rhymes...

E.g. 1 to 4 to the floor, 5 to 9 climb the vine!

1, 2, 3, 4 round down to the number before, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 round up to the next number on the line!

For rounding to the nearest 10, focus on the ones column. For rounding to the nearest 100, focus on the tens column.
