Maths

Throughout this week, we will be revising decimals, tenths and hundredths.

CGP Book task: Page 38 'Rounding Decimals'. TIP: As you are rounding, use your rhyme. '1 to 4 – to the floor, 5 to 9 – climb the vine'. For these questions, the rhyme will apply to the tenths digits.

Challenge: Page 40 'Solving Fraction and Decimal Problems'. TIP: Think carefully about how much you are multiplying or dividing by. How many place value columns do you need to shift the digits? Remember: multiplying – shift to the left, dividing – shift to the right. Drawing the columns may help.
