Reading

Activity: Today, you will be answering comprehension questions based on a piece about Howard Carter (see pdf). You may already know who he is - think back to your Egypt projects! The answers are at the end of the document. Don't peek but do check them after you've finished. You could even improve your work with a purple pen (or whatever colour you have).

We are thrilled that so many children are reading a range of books and we love hearing about what you are reading! Keep reading 5x weekly and updating your reading journals when possible.

If you would like an extra written task this week, write a newspaper report based on an important event in your current book. Newspaper report toolkit: incident details, eyewitness account, direct and reported speech, past tense, layout – name, heading (catchy), pictures with captions.

Activity (you have Tuesday and Wednesday to complete this): Now that you have researched the digestive system, we would like you to write a piece, explaining how it works. Your work should consist of four paragraphs: a short introduction (explaining what the digestive system is), and a paragraph each for what happens in the mouth, stomach and intestines.




Ensure you are clear and include all of the key information about each stage. Feel free to add pictures and labelled diagrams to support your writing.


Q1) Complete these number lines:
