Reading Continue this task from yesterday

Read Part 1 of Amazon Diary – The Jungle Adventures of Alex Winters again. See the ppt version of the story attached. Design an infographic describing the events of the story so far. You need to summarise the story into 6 key parts. Decide what those parts of the story are. Briefly explain the summary of events in the boxes around the map.

In the middle of the page draw a map showing the journey of events and what Alex does in that 1st week when he finds himself in the rainforest. This task should take you 2 days to complete. Day 1 – writing the summary of the story and Day 2 – drawing the map of events.

(This is the same style of task we did for Brightstorm when the airship was attacked in the desert!)

Writing/English Continue this task from yesterday

Yanomami tribe information booklet – 3 days of work (Wednesday and Thursday - reading and writing information, Friday - illustrating)

Read the ppt attached about the Yanomami tribe who inhabit parts of the rainforest in Brazil and Venezuela. This is the tribe mentioned in the Alex Winters Amazon diary.

Design a double page spread or an information booklet about the Yanomami tribe. You will need to include an introduction briefly explaining who the tribe are and where they live then write detailed paragraphs about the tribe. Use the information from the ppt and from the Amazon diary book to explain who the Yanomami are. This is a factual information text so only include facts from the story if you use that for some of your source of information.

Ideas for subheadings are:

- Home – The Shapono
- Food – Farming, Scavenging and Hunting
- Roles of Men and Women
- Celebrations and Feasts
- Threats to their way of life
- Who is helping the Yanomami?
