You may shorten the story slightly however you need to try and keep to the same structure. You may set out your page how you wish.

One day on the savannah a young elephant came across a strange piece of twisted metal. Without knowing what to do she scooped the object up in her trunk and began to play with the odd buttons that lined its shaft. Strange noises burst from the end and she blow down her trunk into the top...

Writing/English

Please look at the map of the world's rainforests and a map of the world labelled with the names of different countries. Your first task is to list where in the world you can find rainforests. Look closely at your maps and work out which countries you can find them in. You could break these into different continents or even draw your own world map, draw the rainforests on and then label them.

Once you have done this please explain what similarities you think there may be with regards to the climate of these places? Do you think all of these areas are exactly alike? Would the animals and plants in these places all be the same do you think and why?

In summary, please locate the rainforests of the world and explain where they are. Once you have done this please explain what you think the similarities and differences are between these rainforests.

Please complete the activities attached today. Firstly you need to order the decimal numbers lowest to highest, think carefully about the place value, which column has the greatest value? Be careful when copying these numbers out. Secondly, please place the greater than, fewer than or equal to symbols between the two pairs of numbers. Remember the crocodile wants to eat more fish! Finally, please order the running times shortest to longest.
