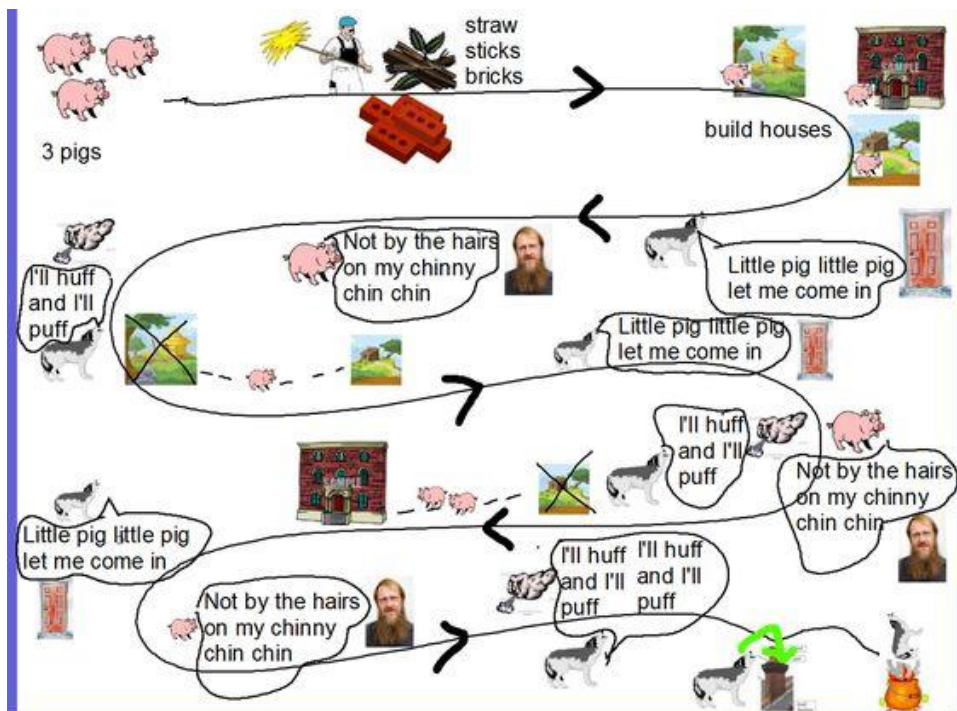
Reading
