current	The flow of water in a certain direction.
deposition landforms	Landscape features made up of material that has been laid down.
erosion landforms	Landscape features resulting from the wearing away of rock.
groyne	A wall built into the sea from the seashore to create a beach by trapping sand carried by longshore drift.
harbour	A harbouris an area of the sea at the coast which is partly enclosed by land or strong walls, so that boats can be left there safely.
headland	A part of the coastline that juts out into the sea and usually ends in a cliff.
