

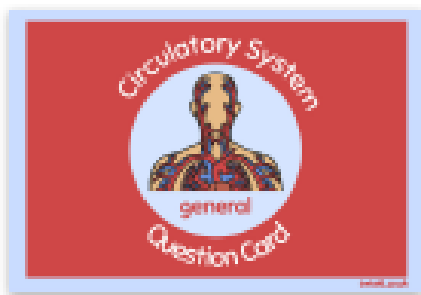
An example game for testing your knowledge on the circulatory system

Below is an adapted game from Twinkl (you can find the original online on their website). It originally required questions to be asked about three categories: the heart, the lungs and the circulatory system. However, we have just included the circulatory system cards.

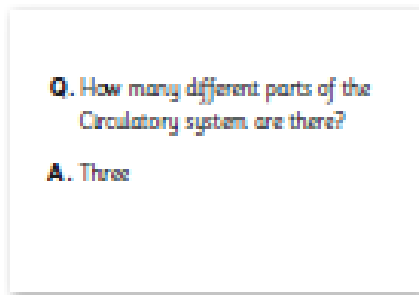
To complete making the game:

- Write the questions on the back of the question cards. Include the answers too.

One side should look like this



The other side with the question and answer should look like:



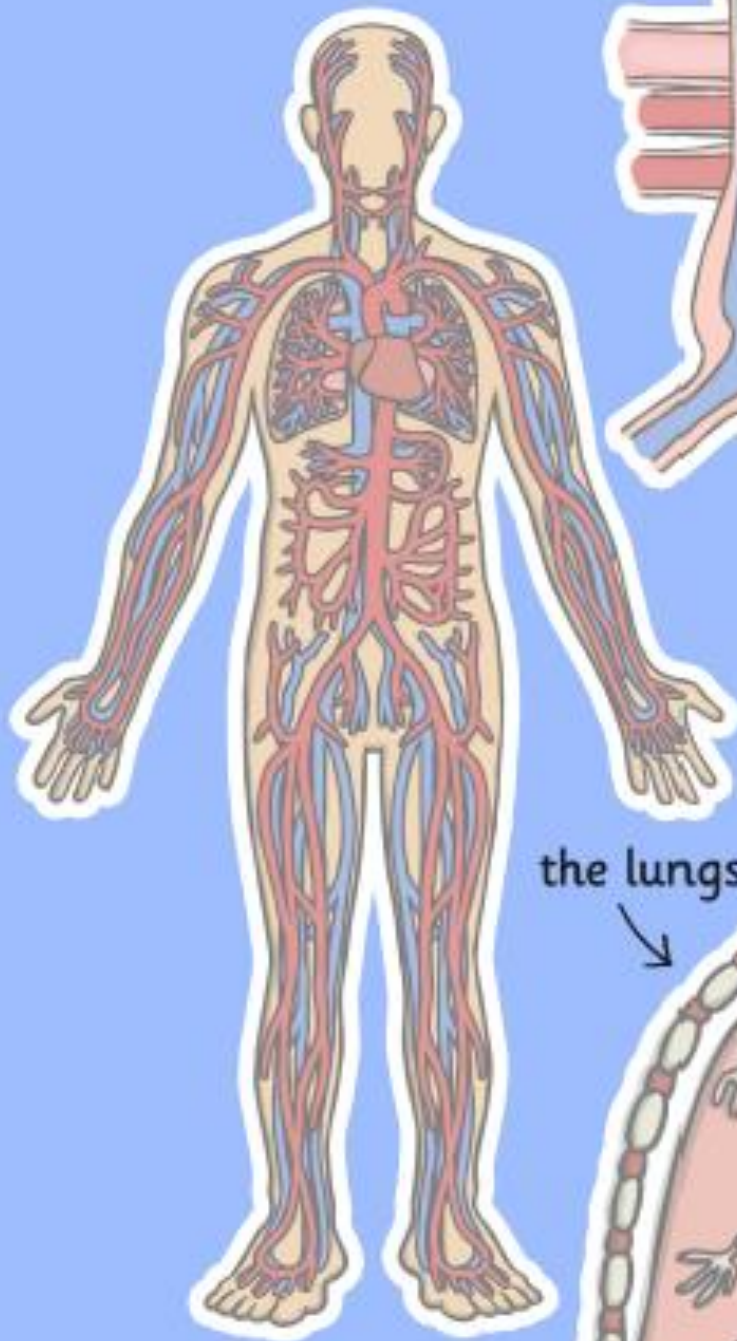
- Cut out the pieces for the game or make your own. You don't have to use them all - you could just include the heart.

Board game instructions:

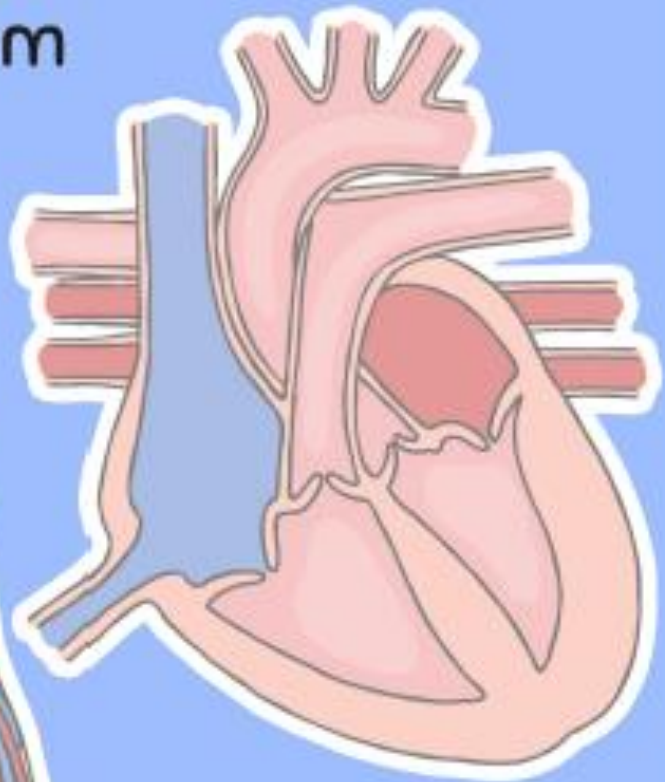
1. Each player receives a board and one complete set of pieces.
2. Roll a die to see what order you will play in.
3. The first player decides which piece they want to play for - either a general piece, a heart piece or a lung piece.
4. Another player picks up a question card and asks the question on the card.
5. If the first player gets the answer right then they get the piece, if they get it wrong, they don't.
6. Take it turns to keep asking questions and trying to win pieces.
7. The first person to get all the pieces wins!
