Can you read a fiction book of your choice with/ to a grown-up? Today we would like you to explore your use of expression. Can you change your tone of voice and make up some voices for the different characters in the story? What do you think the characters' voices sound like? Do they have a loud voice, a quiet voice, a low voice, a squeaky voice? Have fun exploring!

Writing/English

Please see this week's spellings attached at the end of this document. Our spelling words are linked to our fairy story writing.

This week we are going to be writing our own version of 'The Frog Prince'.

Today you are going to plan your story. We have re-attached the story for you, so you may want to read it again!

In your story, we would like you to change the frog to a different animal and the well to a different place where the ball gets thrown.

For example: the prince could be turned into an owl that is in a tree. The ball could get thrown into the tree.

The prince could be turned into a worm that is in a flower bed. The ball could get thrown into the flower bed.

Use your imagination, be creative and make sure the animal links to the place where the princess's ball gets thrown!

Can you draw a picture of and label your chosen animal and place? You could have a go at describing them using interesting adjectives.

Maths

CGP Book Pages: 32 and 33 - multiplication (this is new, and we have not taught this in school yet)

Can you have a go at counting in equal groups using items at home?

For example: 2 lots of 5 teddies is 10.

We suggest doing this practically, and **not** focusing too much on recording the calculations using 'x' at this stage.

We also use the term 'repeated addition' for multiplication. E.g. $3 + 3 + 3 = 9$
