Have a watch of the story time by Miss Snell. You have an important job to do after watching, so remember to listen carefully.

Can you retell the story in your own words?

Which pages are your favourite and why?

For example:

My favourite page is when the penguin and the boy are in the boat setting off into the vast sea. I like it because they look like adventurers. They seem very hopeful and look like they are enjoying being on the deep blue ocean. My least favourite page is the storm page because it looks scary. The waves look choppy and the boat is rocking.

We have attached some pictures of the characters from the story of The Frog Prince (the prince, the frog, the princess and the fairy).

Today we would like you to choose a character, draw your own picture of them and write a character description, describing what they are like as a character and their appearance (what they look like). Remember to use exciting sentence starters and adjectives!

For example:

The fairy

The fairy is an evil character in the story because she turns the innocent prince into a slimy green frog without a reason and places him in a dark well. She is wearing a long black cloak that drapes over her shoulders, which makes her look mysterious. Her long blue hair curls down to her hips and she holds her magic wand, ready to cast a spell. Interestingly, her face looks unimpressed and the prince looks terrified of the fairy.

Do write about more than one character if you want to! 😊
