

This clock shows 4 o'clock

Time information

Miss Snell's magical maths!

Analog clock



Minute hand
The minute hand tells us how many minutes past the hour it is. If it is at 12 it is o'clock. If it is at 6, it is half past.

Hour hand
The hour hand tells the hour. If the hand points at the hour it is o'clock. If it is half way it is half past!

Digital clock

A digital clock can be 12 hour or 24 hours. 18:00 is bpm in the evening. You might find a digital clock on an oven.

- 60 Seconds in a minute
- 60 minutes in an hour
- 24 hours in a day
- 12 hours of day
- 12 hours of night
- 7 days in a week
- 12 months a year
- 30 days has September, April, June and November
- All the rest have 31 except February, which has 28 or 29 in a leap year
