Reading/ Writing

How many words can you think of and record with the alternate ay / ai / a-e sounds in?

You might want to split your page into 3 with ay, ai and a-e.

For example:

ay - play, tray

ai - train, paid

a-e - gate, flake

If you're not sure, use 'best bet' to write your word out in the three different ways and work out which one looks correct! For example: mayk, maik, **make**. I know that the correct spelling is **make**, which contains a-e.
