qu, ch, sh, th, ng, ay, ai, a-e, ee, ea, e-e, igh, ie, i-e, ow, oa, o-e, oo, ew, u-e, er, ur, ir, or, au, aw, ou, ow, oy, oi, ar, air, are, ear, ure.

You might find some other, trickier digraphs and trigraphs as you are reading!
