English - Writing

It's letter writing time! As guardians of our galaxy, it is our job to think of ways to be more eco-friendly! Key features of a letter you may wish to include:

to and from	address	date	sectioned writing	question sentences	conjunctions	commas in a list	appreciation and signing off
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Day 1- planning your letter- what are your ideas that you want to communicate? Why are these ideas important?

Day 2 – to and introduction – who are you? Why are you writing this letter?

Day 3- section number 1 explain your first idea – why should Kingslea try your idea?

Day 4- section number 2 explain your second idea – why should Kingslea try your idea?

Day 5- ask the reader some questions about your ideas, add your appreciation (remember to say thank you) and sign off (from/yours sincerely) Remember to proof-read and edit.
