The SPAG sheet has been attached as a separate document 😊

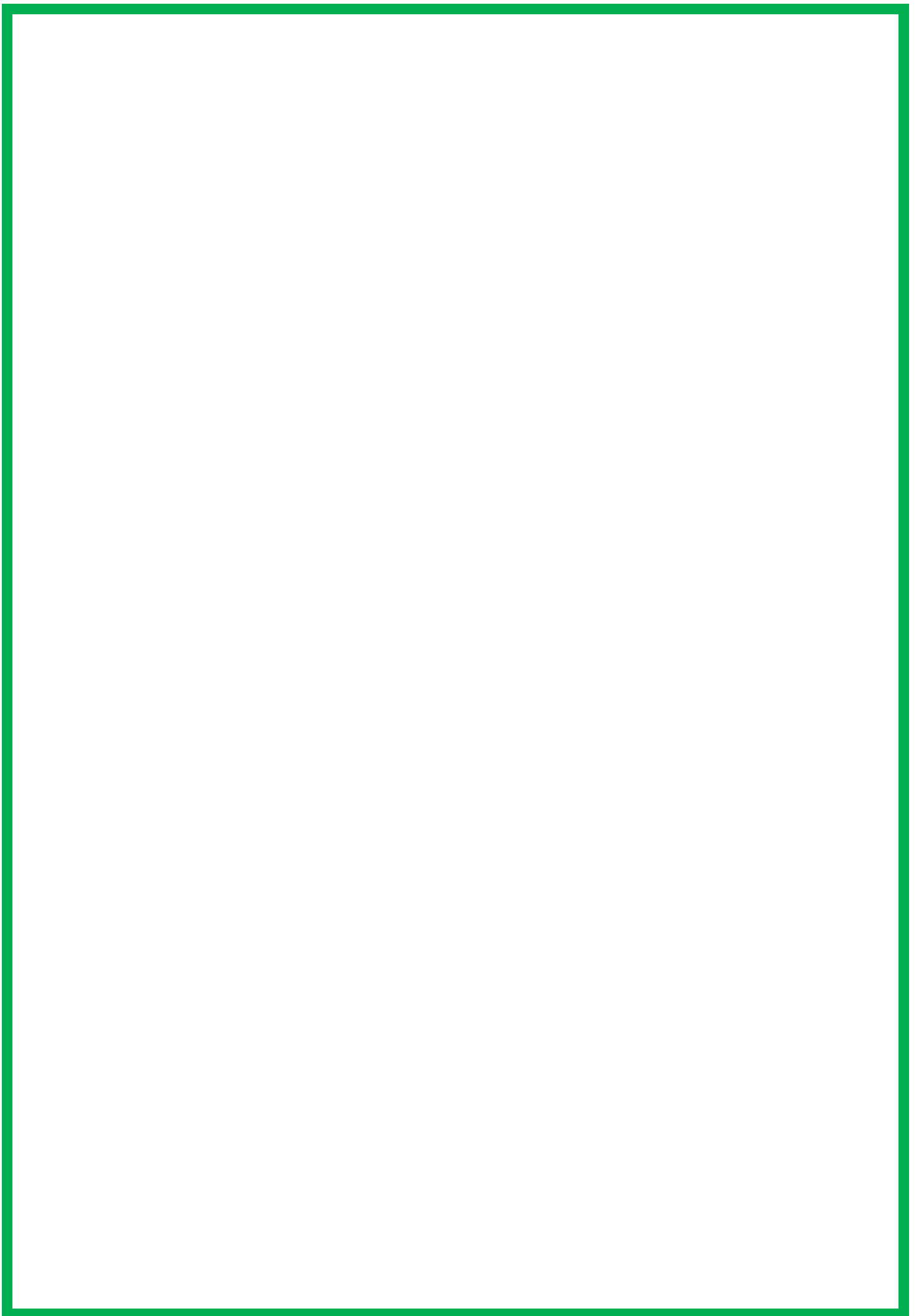
English - Writing

Time to continue our story writing project based on the text Flotsam by David Wiesner. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3MTKWnxzqvM> Aim for each activity to take you around 15-20 minutes as these are short burst writing activities.

Activity Ten – our last session!

- Now comes the time that we need to finish your story – well done for working so hard on it for the last two weeks!
- Your character is left with the underwater camera. In the text Flotsam the character throws it back into the sea.
- What does your character decided to do with the camera?
- Will you decide on a different ending for your story? The decision is yours!

Congratulations on finishing your story! When we complete writing projects at school, we often spend some time publishing them. If you want to publish your story, please do – there are many ways to do this. You could create your own publishing paper, use lined paper or fold paper to create a mini book. You could even try typing it up (ask your grown up first!) This activity isn't a requirement just more of a choice! Please save them so we can read them when we return to school 😊



Maths - CGP Books

Arithmetic book – Page 24 – 2 times table - dividing

- It is time to begin using the inverse operation to multiplication – division!
- Remember, if you know your multiplication facts for this times table then you can just apply this understanding to your division facts.

Reasoning book – Page 16– checking

- Another chance for you to practise using the inverse – this time with the operations of addition and subtraction.
