English - Writing

Time to continue our story writing project based on the text Flotsam by David Wiesner. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3MTKWnxzqyM> Aim for each activity to take you around 15-20 minutes as these are short burst writing activities.

Activity Five

- Your character looks at the first photograph from the packet. Choose one of the images from the Flotsam text for this writing section.

- Explain to the reader what your character can see. What is in the picture? What is happening?
- How does your character feel when looking at this unusual image?
- How does your character feel this image could have been created?
- Does your character believe that these images are real? Did these unusual events actually happen or was it just magic?

Maths - CGP Books

Arithmetic book – Page 19 – Mixed problems

- Now you can put your arithmetic skills to the test!
- Remember to use your jottings to help you – make sure that they are smart so your answers are accurate.
- You need to check which operation is being used in each calculation. Is it asking you to add or subtract? Good luck!

Reasoning book – Page 10 – Ordering and patterns

- Take a look at question 4. What would the 6th triangle in the sequence look like. Try drawing it in your book.

Online Homework

- It is a Numbots week! Can you use this week to earn some more coins? Will you move up to the next stage in the junkyard? This could take you some time or weeks so don't worry if you don't progress to the next stage quickly. The practising of your skills is more important!
- The Numbots junkyard levels run in the following order and ranking:
