English - Writing

It's letter writing time! As guardians of our galaxy, it is our job to think of ways to be more eco-friendly! For this week's writing unit, we would like you think about ways that we could make our school more environmentally friendly. Do you think we could introduce more recycling bins in school? Key features of a letter you may wish to include:

to and from	address	date	sectioned writing	question sentences	conjunctions	commas in a list	appreciation and signing off
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Day 1- planning your letter- what are your ideas that you want to communicate? Why are these ideas important?

Day 2 – to and introduction – who are you? Why are you writing this letter?

Day 3- section number 1 explain your first idea – why should Kingslea try your idea?

Day 4- section number 2 explain your second idea – why should Kingslea try your idea?

Day 5- ask the reader some questions about your ideas, add your appreciation (remember to say thank you) and sign off (from/yours sincerely) Remember to proof-read and edit.

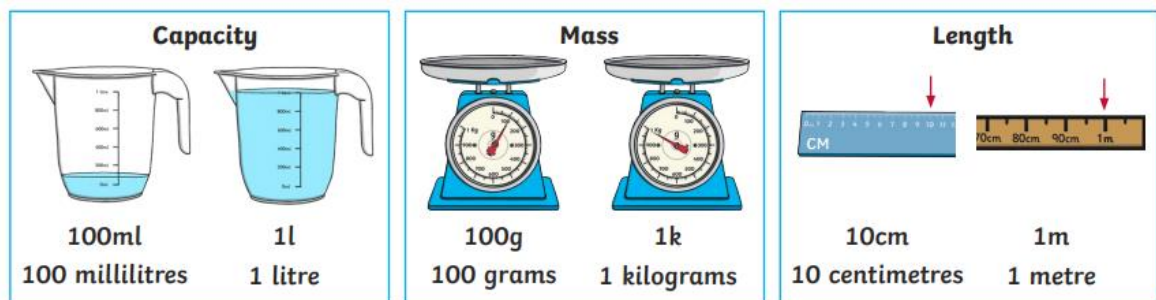
Maths - CGP Books
