Have a go at completing a Year 2 SPAG mat. Remember SPAG stands for spelling, punctuation and grammar. Use what you have been taught at school to help you to answer these questions. Ask your grown up nicely if they can check your work for you. Make sure you use your best presentation and handwriting too.

English - Writing

Time to continue our story writing project based on the text Flotsam by David Wiesner. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3MTKWnxzqvM> Aim for each activity to take you around 15-20 minutes as these are short burst writing activities.

Activity Two

- Your character goes exploring. Where do they go? What do they look at?
- How is your character feeling as they are exploring?
- Suddenly something happens... in Flotsam a wave hits the boy and knocks him over. What sudden event will happen in your story?
- When the sudden event passes your character finds an underwater camera (this is flotsam – flotsam can be discarded objects washed up or floating on the sea)
- How does your character feel when they make this discovery?

Maths - CGP Books

Arithmetic book – Page 13 – Subtraction of multiples of 10 from 2-digit numbers

- If you are out on your daily walk today look out for house numbers with 2 digits. When you find one ask your grown up to give you a multiple of ten to subtract from it. If you fancy an

extra challenge look for house numbers with 3 digits. Remember – use what you know... what stays the same? What is different?

Reasoning book – Page 7 – Number lines

- Look at question 4. Have a go at placing the answers to these questions on the number lines too.
- Double 7
- $38 - 16$
- 11×2
- $30 \div 5$
- Remember you can use jottings to help you to solve these calculations

Online Homework

- It is a Numbots week! Can you use this week to earn some more coins? Will you move up to the next stage in the junkyard? This could take you some time or weeks so don't worry if you don't progress to the next stage quickly. The practising of your skills is more important!
- The Numbots junkyard levels run in the following order and ranking:

Rust	Iron	Tin	Brass	Copper	Steel
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- As a smaller weekly target - aim to try and improve your rankings by 10 levels. Each level looks like this:



- Look at which level you started the week on and see how far you can progress – good luck!
