### Reading

- Please ensure that you read for at least 15 minutes per day. Write us a comment in your reading journal to summarise what happened in your text (if you would like to email us these please do!).
- Complete one page in your CGP comprehension booklet – ask your grown up to check your answers. Remember key words need to be spelt correctly and highlight your answers from the text.

### Phonics

Time for some more phonics fun! Teach your grown-ups how to play 'Quiz Quiz Trade' following these instructions:

- Before you begin, create a bank of words with the digraph wr (write).
- Once you've created your word bank, cut these words up or write them on small strips of paper and place them somewhere safe. This will make it easier to quiz and trade later.
- Make sure that each player has a word.
- Play some music if you wish.
- When the music stops, show your partner your word. Quiz them! Do they know what the word says? If they do you can 'trade' by giving them your slip of paper. Ask your partner to quiz you on their word. If you get it right, you can trade. If not, have another go!
- As there won't be as many players as we normally have, use new words from your bank when you have traded your words.

## English - Writing

- Your writing project this week is to create a fact file about Australia!
- We will give you an area to focus on each day.
- You can present your project however you wish.
- Try to use these grammar and key features in your fact file:

Catchy sub-headings	Captions for pictures	A map showing the major cities and territories	Expanded noun phrases White, sandy beaches	Conjunctions but, and, so, because	Commas in a list

- Day Two – What animals live in Australia?
- Day Three – Research a famous city in Australia

## Maths - CGP Books

### Arithmetic book – Page 8 – Addition of 2-digit numbers and tens

- Explain to your grown up what stays the same and what is different when you add a multiple of ten to any number.

### Reasoning book – Page 1 – Numbers 1-20

- Create a number word mat to help you to correctly spell these words. You will need to include:
  - The digits 0-9
  - The teen numbers 11 – 19
  - Multiples of ten
  - As an extra challenge you could include multiples of 100 too
- When your word mat has been created ask your grown up to write you 10 numbers between 1 and 100 for you to spell correctly.
- We have put an example of a word mat as inspiration at the bottom of this document 😊
