### Reading

- Please ensure that you read for at least 15 minutes per day. Write us a comment in your reading journal to summarise what happened in your text.

### Spelling

- We are going to practise the alternate ways to spell the 'j' sound spelt ge and dge.
- We have already covered these spellings in Year 2 so this is just revision – try to think back and use what you know.
- There is a handy explanation about these spelling patterns to remind you too.
- Have a look at the spelling card attached and complete the activities for each spelling pattern.
- You might think of more words that use these spellings that you can add to the lists.

### English - Writing

- For our next two writing units we are going to focus on our non-fiction writing.
- This week, we would like you to create a fact page about plastic. You can choose how to present your work to the reader.
- You might wish to include some non-fiction features such as:

photos	pictures	diagrams	sub-headings	captions	text boxes	bold writing	a glossary
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Day 1 – Where does plastic come from? How is it made?

Day 2 – What do we use plastic for?

Day 3 – Why has plastic become a problem? What problems does it cause?

Day 4 – What are the benefits of using plastic?

Day 5 – How could we use plastic responsibly?

## Maths - CGP Books

### Arithmetic book – Page 26 - 5 times table - multiplying

- Have a go at creating a times table poster for the 5 times table (this could go next to your 2 times table poster if you made one last time!) Remember to include the division facts too to help them to remain in your memory.

### Reasoning book – Page 21 - Thirds

- For question 3 you could use your division jottings to help you find the correct answer. You will need 3 sharing boxes and share the whole amount equally between the 3 sharing boxes.
- Can you cut your lunch into thirds? How many thirds do you have left if you eat two thirds?
