Spelling

- Today's activity is focused on homophones.
- Remember, homophones are words that sound the same, are spelt differently but mean different things
- Examples of homophones include – see and sea
- We have provided you with some homophone cards that need matching up with their correct definition.
- You could play this game in different ways. You could play it as a matching game to simply match the homophones and definitions or turn the cards upside down and create a memory game to make the matching more difficult.
- The way you play is up to you! Happy homophone work!

English - Writing

- Time to enjoy some personal writing! For your writing tasks this week, we would like you to spend 15-20 minutes per day completing some personal writing.
- We would like to give you the freedom and choice about what you want to write about and how you will do this.
- In the inside cover of your purple personal writing book, there is a grid of different pieces of writing that you may wish you use.
- You may want to choose a different box from the grid each day or chose one and work on the one piece of writing across the course of the week.
