Phonics

Time for a Year 2 favourite! Today we would like you to play a memory game to practise reading this tricky family of words that end with the l sound. The tricky part is that the l sound can be spelt in various ways – le, el, il and al. If we build our reading memory with these words we will have a better chance at spelling them more accurately in the future.

We have provided you with a bank of words at the end of this document which you are welcome to use to play the game or if you want to create your own cards please feel free to do so.

1. Cut out or create your word cards. You need two copies of each word.
2. Turn your word cards upside down and spread them out in front of the players – none of the words should be able to be read.
3. Player 1 turns two word cards over and reads them aloud. If the word cards match, Player 1 can keep the cards and take a bonus turn at turning another 2 cards over.
4. If the cards do not match then they need to be turned back upside down and it is time for Player 2's turn.
5. Remember to memorise where each card is so you can match them up later in the game!
6. The winner is the player with the most amount of matched word cards. Good luck!

English - Writing

Time to continue our story writing project based on the text Flotsam by David Wiesner. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3MTKWnxzqyM> Aim for each activity to take you around 15-20 minutes as these are short burst writing activities.

Activity Three

- Your character walks the length of the beach to see if they can find the owner of the camera.
- Who do they ask? What do they say? What questions do they ask?
- No one claims the underwater camera as their own. How does your character feel?
- Your character begins to explore the camera. What is the camera like? What does it look like? Feel like? How heavy is it? What features does it have?
- Your character notices that there is still a film inside the camera. What should your character do?

Maths - CGP Books

Arithmetic book – Page 14 – Subtraction of 2-digit numbers from 2-digit numbers

- Remember to use your careful jottings to solve these calculations. Remember you need to subtract the ones and then the tens. Good luck!

Reasoning book – Page 8 – Comparing numbers

- Go on a number hunt around your home. There are numbers everywhere! Find two numbers and compare them using the comparison symbols $<$ $>$ or $=$. Then find some more! Can you find and compare number in each room in your home?
