English - Writing

Time to continue our story writing project based on the text Flotsam by David Wiesner.

Activity Eight

- Your character finishes looking at all of the photographs. How is your character feeling?
- The photographs were different – the first was happier and showed wildlife enjoying their habitat under the sea.
- How does your character feel when looking at the images when litter became the flotsam in the story?
- Which photograph does your character feel is the most shocking? Why?
- How could your character fix this problem? What could they do?

Maths - CGP Books

Arithmetic book – Page 22 – 2 times table

- Have a go at making your own times table poster to decorate your house with. This will help these important multiplication facts remain in your memory.
- Challenge – can you include the division facts too?

Reasoning book – Page 13 – Addition and subtraction problems continued!

- Remember, you can use your jottings to help you – space has been provided
- Ensure that your jottings are smart to enable you to have more accurate answers
- Be careful – check the operation in the problem. Is it asking you to add or subtract? Good luck!

Online Homework

- It is a TT week! You have 10 garage games to complete this week – you can always do more!
- Remember the garage is designed around your current learning.
- If you are feeling brave, try playing in the studio. This will give you practice with all questions up to 12x12 – remember you don't need to know all multiplication these facts until the end of Year 4. There is no harm in practising though and having a little fun!
- A smaller target to achieve – look at which training level you started the week on and see how far you can progress. Can you move 5 training levels this week? Or more than 10? Good luck!
