

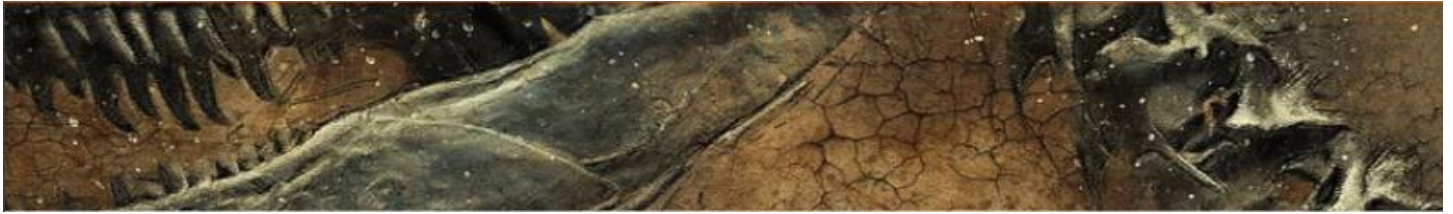




# Velociraptors

Velociraptors were small dinosaurs. They walked on two legs and had short arms. They had a large claw on each foot. They were only half a meter tall at the hips. Scientists think that they may have had feathers as well. That is very different to the ones in the film!
