
<u>Place Value (Part 4)</u> <u>Roman Numerals</u>

The rules that must be followed for accurate use of Roman numerals are as follows:

- 1. Symbols are written from left to right in value order.
- To avoid having four characters in a row, some characters can be subtracted from others when placed BEFORE them.
- 3. I placed before V or X indicates one less.
- 4. X placed before L or C indicates ten less.
- 5. C placed before D or M indicates a hundred less.


