Can you write foods you like and don't like?

The Hungry Caterpillar ate lots of different food in the story. Can you write a list of foods you do like and don't like?

Maths

Explore how to find half of a shape or a number with an adult (both attached). Can you get 2 teddy bears and 10 items/sweets/grapes/bits of pasta etc and then give each teddy bear half? Can you do this with 8, 6, 4, 2 items? Write the numbers down on a piece of paper, choose one, count that number of items out carefully and then give each teddy bear half. Can you always find half of a number? What about half of 3, 5 or 7? Do both teddy bears have the same amount?
