

Writing/English

Can you write a list of jungle animals?





Maths

Same game as yesterday, but in reverse! Can you write the numbers 0-20 on a strip of paper, or in your book? Collect 20 counters, coins, blocks, pompoms etc and get them ready to play a game with someone else.

1 – Roll a dice

2 – Place that many counters over the numbers you have written starting at 20. Eg – if you roll 4, then put a counter on the numbers 20, 19, 18, 17. If the next person rolls a 3 then they place their counters on numbers 16, 15, 14

3 – Take turns with a friend

4 – Continue this until you reach 0
