#### **Reading**

Play a tricky word matching game. Cut out 12 rectangles of paper (big enough to write a word on each). Ask your child to write some tricky words on the paper. There should be two of each tricky word (only 6 tricky words if using 12 slips of paper). Turn them over and mix them up. Take it in turns to turn over two cards and try to match the tricky words. Remember to encourage your child to read the words carefully. You could do this with more paper and words if you like a challenge!
